- Timeframe: 2-4 years (depending on trial scheduling)

#### 4 Settlement Negotiations & Compensation Offers

- Based on trial results, **defendants may propose payouts** to settle cases.
- Lawyers negotiate the highest possible compensation for plaintiffs.
- Plaintiffs can accept, reject, or negotiate further.

Timeframe: 6 months - 2 years

#### 5 Resolution: Settlement or Trial

- If a **settlement is reached**, funds are distributed based on case severity.
- If **no agreement is made**, more cases may go to trial.
- Appeals may extend the timeline for final payouts.

Timeframe: 3+ years if trial is required

#### **Expert Witnesses**

Expert testimony is crucial in proving the connection between the harmful product and injuries. Common experts include:

- Medical Experts Testify about injuries caused by the product.
- Scientists & Researchers Provide studies linking the product to health risks.
