💰 Types of Compensation in Mass Tort Cases

Compensation in mass tort lawsuits typically falls into three categories:

1 Economic Damages (Financial Losses)

- ✓ Medical Expenses Covers past, present, and future medical treatments, surgeries, rehabilitation, and prescription costs.
- ✓ Lost Wages & Reduced Earning Capacity Compensation for missed work due to injury and loss of future earning potential.
- ✓ Out-of-Pocket Costs Travel expenses for medical treatment, home modifications, and assistive devices.

2 Non-Economic Damages (Pain & Suffering)

- ✓ Physical Pain & Emotional Distress Compensation for ongoing pain, suffering, anxiety, depression, and reduced quality of life.
- ✓ Loss of Consortium Compensation for the impact of the injury on relationships with family or a spouse.
- ✓ Loss of Enjoyment of Life If the injury prevents the victim from participating in activities they once enjoyed.

3 Punitive Damages (In Rare Cases)

✓ Awarded in cases of gross negligence or misconduct, punishing the defendant for reckless behavior (e.g., knowingly selling a harmful product).

Factors That Impact Settlement Amounts

The amount of compensation varies based on several key factors:

- Severity of Injury More serious injuries typically result in higher payouts.
- Extent of Medical Treatment Long-term or permanent health complications increase compensation.
 - Strength of Evidence Clear proof linking the injury to the product strengthens the case.
- Number of Plaintiffs Larger lawsuits often lead to tiered settlements based on injury severity.
- Trial vs. Settlement Outcome Cases that go to trial may yield higher awards but take longer to resolve.

How Compensation Is Calculated & Distributed

Unlike class actions where all plaintiffs receive an equal share, mass tort settlements are calculated based on individual circumstances.

- ✓ Tiered Payout System Plaintiffs are categorized by injury severity, with higher tiers receiving larger settlements.
- ✓ Multiplier Method Pain and suffering compensation is often calculated using a multiplier (1.5x - 5x) applied to economic damages.
- ✓ Settlement vs. Trial Compensation Many mass tort cases settle, but trials can result in larger payouts—though they take longer.

Roundup (Glyphosate)	\$10.9 Billion	\$100,000 - \$250,000 per case
Opioid Epidemic Lawsuits	\$26 Billion	Varies based on state and injuries

Johnson & Johnson Talcum Powder	\$8.9 Billion	Up to \$300,000 per plaintiff
Hernia Mesh Defects	\$2 Billion+	\$50,000 - \$1 Million per person
Camp Lejeune Water Contamination	Ongoing	Varies depending on illness severity
